Decorating Easter Eggs



Decorating Easter Eggs is a fun **Easter** tradition for many families. Your family's decorating options can be as elaborate or as simple as you wish. The age of your children will need to be considered.

First boil the eggs. Then decide on your dye colors. For rich dye colors, use food coloring paste. Here are some decorating options:

- Small children will enjoy dipping the eggs in different colors of dye.
- Small children may also enjoy simply sticking cute stickers on the eggs.
- You may put a sticker with their initial on the egg and then dye the egg. Once dried, remove the sticker and the initial will stand out white amongst all of the dye colors.

- Put rubber bands around the egg, then dip in dye, once dried you can remove the rubber bands.
- Paint faces or designs on the eggs with paints.
